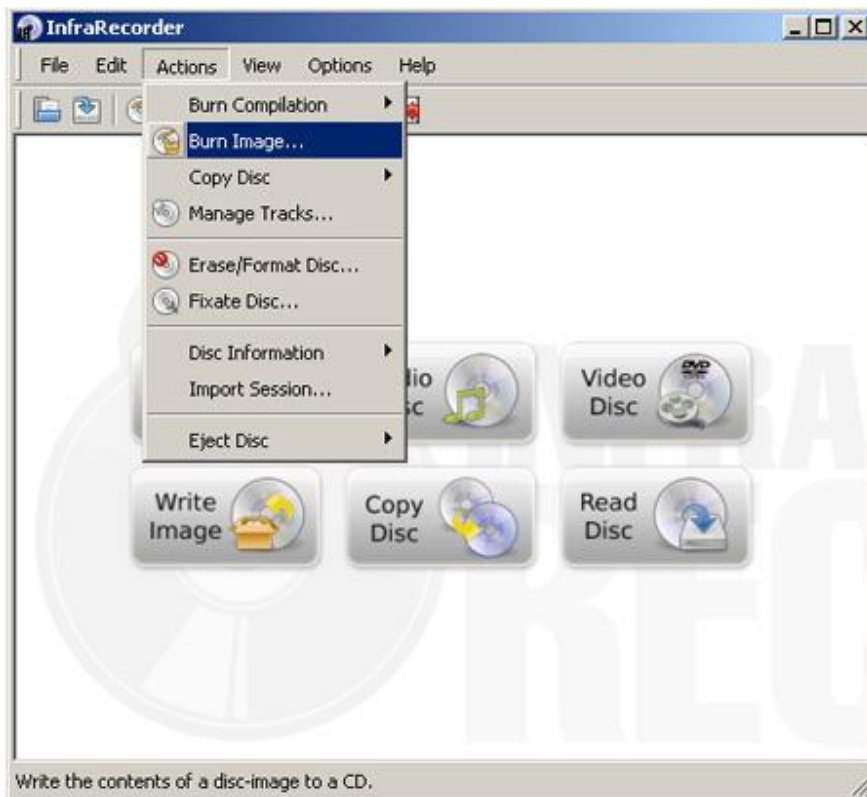


95 / 98 / ME / 2000 / XP / Server 2003 / Vista: Infra Recorder

1. Download and install [Infra Recorder](http://infrarecorder.sourceforge.net/) (<http://infrarecorder.sourceforge.net/>), a free and open-source image-burning program.
2. Insert a blank CD in the drive and select **Do nothing** or **Cancel** if an autorun dialog box pops up.
3. Open Infra Recorder and click the 'Write Image' button in the main screen.

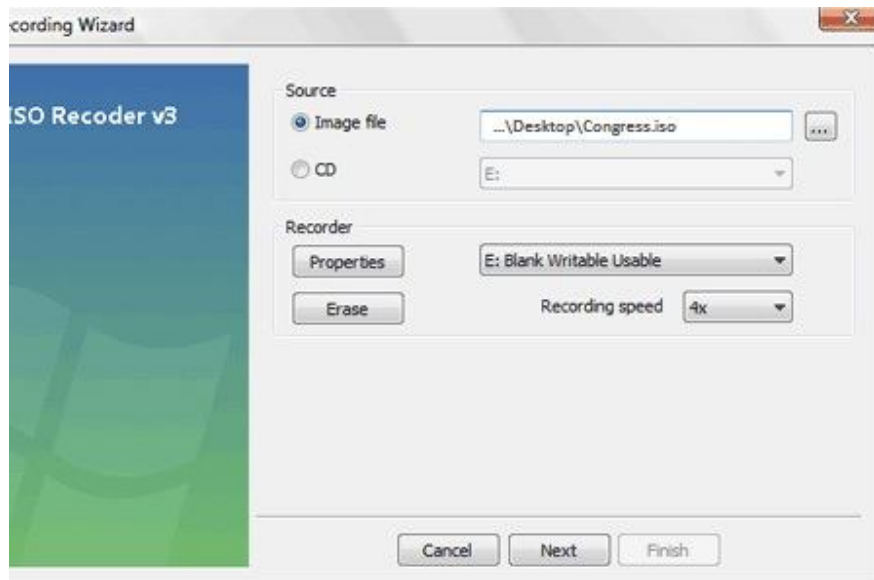
-Alternatively you can select the 'Actions' menu, then 'Burn image'.

4. Select the Congress CD image file you want to use, then click 'Open'.
5. In the dialog box, click 'OK'.



XP / Server 2003 / Vista: ISO Recorder

1. Download and install the appropriate version of [ISO Recorder](http://isorecorder.alexfeinman.com/isorecorder.htm) (<http://isorecorder.alexfeinman.com/isorecorder.htm>).
2. Insert a blank CD into your burner. Open Windows Explorer, find your Congress ISO file, right-click and choose 'Next'.



Windows 7

Right-click on an Congress ISO image and choose 'Burn disc image'.

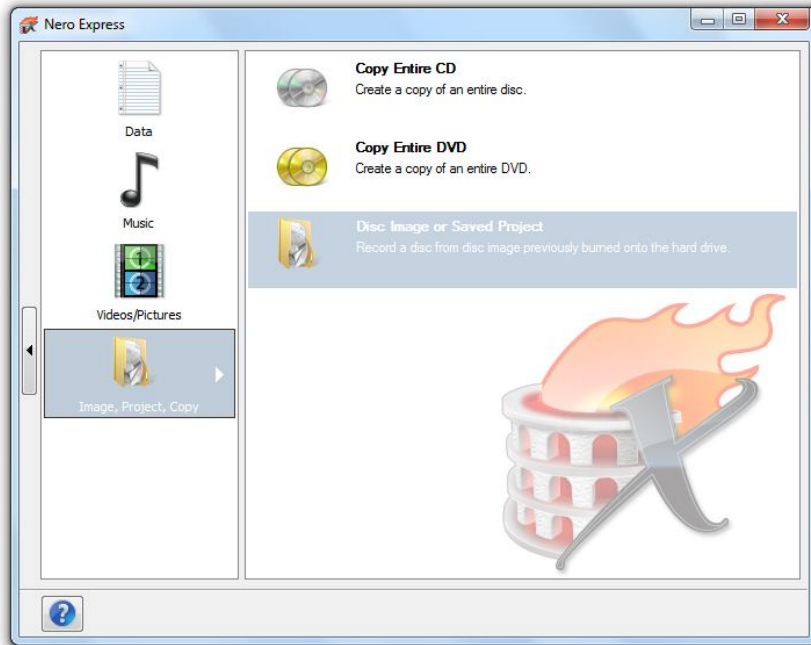


Select a disk burner (drive) and choose 'Burn'. If you check 'Verify disc after burning', it will confirm that the ISO image has been burned correctly.

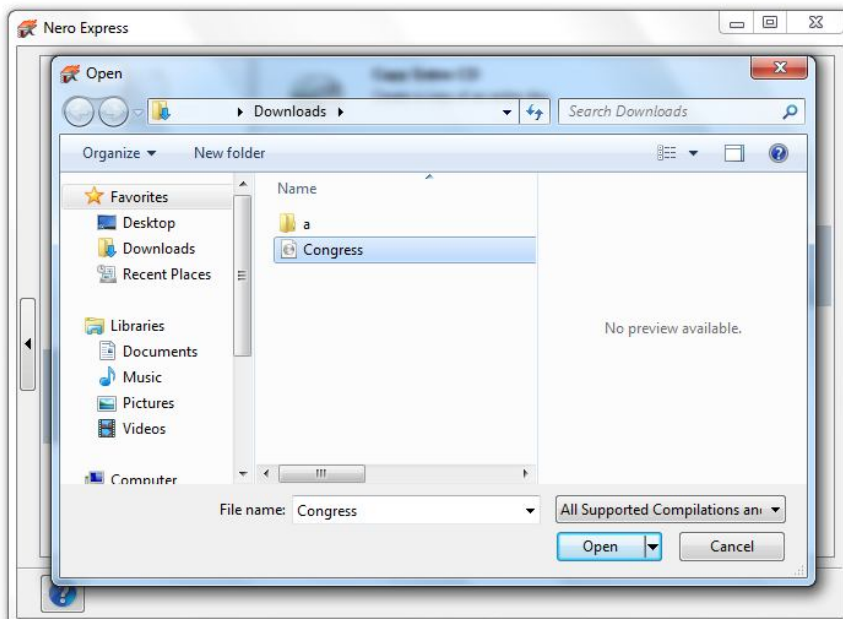


Nero Express

Insert a blank CD in the drive and start Nero express. Choose **Image, Project, Copy** and select **Disk Image or Saved Project**.



Select the 'Congress' iso file and click the 'Open' button.



Click the 'Burn' button (You can choose – 'Verify data on disc after burning') and wait until the burning process is finished.
